I was invited to present three one-hour programs on studio lighting. My first morning event had just under 100 people in the room. Good thing, as we had a few problems with the software and called upon Canon Professionals to help us get going. My second presentation was in the afternoon leaving me with seven empty chairs, and a much more enthusiastic, question-asking crowd. After the program we counted 304 seats in the room giving me a total 297 viewers for that program – wow! My third program was Sunday afternoon and it still brought in just over 150 attendees. Over all, it was much more than I expected to see walking through my doors.

NCC is the proud owner of a new digital projector. The e-board has met and agreed on the best fit for our club. Part of the process was projecting your competition entries through the same projector and on to a new screen, making sure we would have the best resolution, color saturation, and light balance to accommodate a wide range

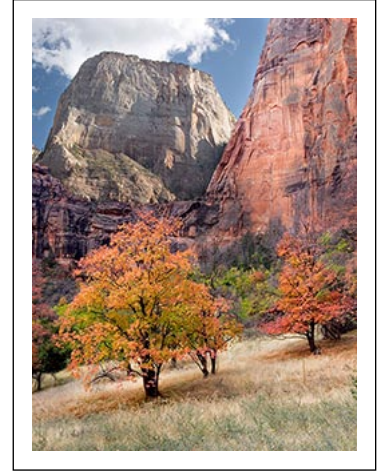

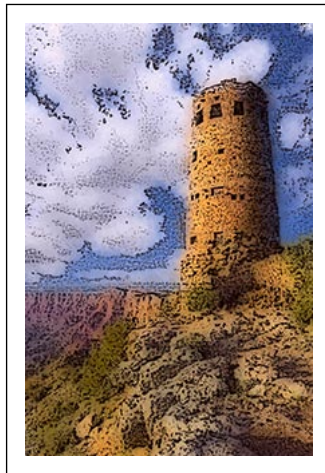
